WHILE £400-600 is a lot of cash to let you splash, the performance increase over entry-level suits is marked, your extra money going into cutting edge materials to improve flexibility and buoyancy, making a top-end suit a wise investment, especially for Ironman racers.

Being so spoilt for choice with high-performance suits this year, picking a winner has been a truly difficult decision.

The Zone3 Vanquish has to be called out for its astonishing arm freedom, exceptional buoyancy and keen pricing. It remains one of the fastest suits to slip out of in T1, too. The Mako eXtreme won us over with its 'just right' cut and free arm movement while the Orca Enduro 3.8 was one of the comfiest, most flexible suits we've ever swum in. Blueseventy's Helix proves itself again as a stunningly fast and comfortable suit, it's super thin sleeves keeping arms fresh all day. The Sailfish G-range might have a bonkers price, but it really is a stunner in performance terms too.

All these suits are deserved of praise, but for its blistering speed, luxurious comfort, perfect buoyancy distribution, unbelievable flexibility and amazing price point, the Nineteen Rogue sweeps the board to take our Top Value, Peak Performer and Gold awards.
